



Unit participation in the Reflections program on the County level

- PTA must be in good standing with NCPTA.
- PTA must have paid their Council dues and Reflection fees.
- Follow the [PARTICIPANT RULES](#) regarding the artwork specifications to be submitted for the School's Reflection program.

NOTE: For clarification of a Special Artist, see page 4 of [LOCAL LEADER'S GUIDE](#).

NOTE: Students who identify as having a disability and may receive services under IDEA or ADA: Section 504 may enter in the Special Artist Division or Grade Division most closely aligned to their functional abilities.

- Share the [REVIEWER INSTRUCTIONS](#) packet with your judges in reviewing of artwork submissions.
- Announce your school's winners and host a Reflections celebration. Each school may choose their own submission deadlines and celebration date.
- Deadline to submit artwork to the WCPTA for judging is Friday, November 30th no later than 11:59 pm.

- **WCPTA will accept 14 entries per grade division regardless of categories from each school.** Specially: 14 entries will be accepted from Primary (Preschool – Grade 2), 14 entries will be accepted from Intermediate (Grades 3 – 5), 14 entries will be accepted from Middle School (Grades 6 – 8), 14 entries from High School (Grades 9 – 12). Unlimited entries from Special Artists.

- Process for transmitting entries to WCPTA

1. Create a Unit's Reflections Gmail account following this format for your school:

For example, CoolkidsSchoolReflections@gmail.com. This will give your unit Google Drive

[FORM](#) and the [STUDENT ENTRY FORMS](#). ****Student Entry Forms are fillable***** Scan each student entry form and artwork submission as an individual file to be uploaded for judging on the County level.

NOTE: Student Entry Forms must be filled out completely. Student entries must follow the North Carolina PTA Reflections Category Rules and presentation submission requirements as listed on the Participant Rules and [LOCAL LEADERS GUIDE \(pages 5 – 7\)](#). **Do not deviate from these rules or the submission will be disqualified and will not be reviewed by the judges.**

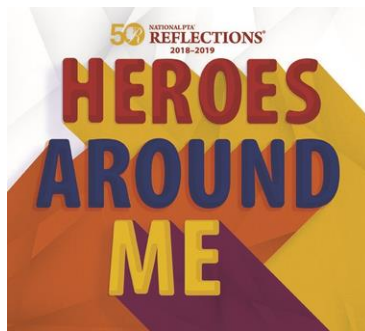
2. The Unit's Reflections drive must separate folders. **One folder for each of the following categories. Unless there are no entries for that category, which must be specified on the Local PTA Unit Participation form:** Dance Choreography, Film Production, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, Visual Arts, Special Artists. Each folder will store the corresponding art entries and student entry forms.

NOTE: Students can have multiple entries in the same or multiple categories. Each entry must have a separate student entry form.

3. Units must **SHARE** each folder with reflectionswakecountyppta@gmail.com with the ability to **EDIT**. Ensure you include the artwork submissions for the category, the student's entry form, and the Local Unit Participation form in each folder.
4. County level winners will be announced on January 3, 2019 via email to the Reflections Chairs and posted on the website.
5. The Wake County Council will submit up to 30 entries and all Special Artists artwork for judging to NCPTA in early January.

WCPTA Awards Ceremony will be held in March 2019. Details TBA.
